

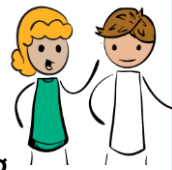

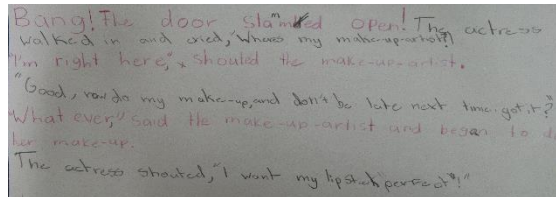

Unit of Inquiry
