

# There are no winners in war...

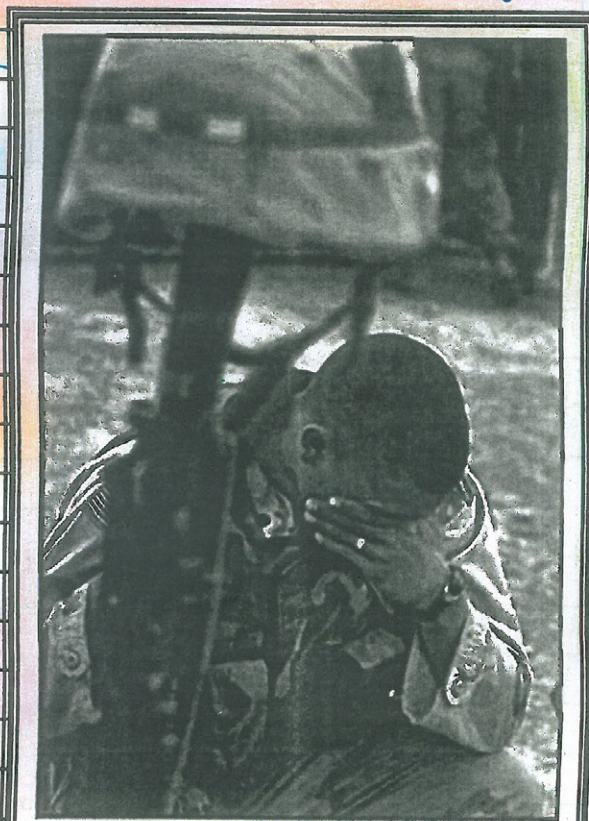
